

- BB trust has also donated a solar light for Bright Peace Old Aged Home (Senior citizen's home). Elderly citizen residing in there are now able to see and do their chores even in the absence of electricity.
- BB trust has supported with Rs15, 000 to Dawadi Milan Club so that they could conduct a Free Health Check Up Camp and distribute free medicine to the poor people who has suffered from different kinds of diseases in the community.
